

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
MINUTES OF MEETING OF OCTOBER 9, 2006**

The Wrightstown Township Board of Supervisors Work Session was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice-Chair Jane B. Magne, Member/Treasurer Robert S. Lloyd, Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley, and Township Solicitor Terry W. Clemons.

**Verizon Franchise Agreement:** Verizon Franchise Manager Edward Butts appeared to review the terms of the proposed Verizon Franchise Agreement. The Board directed questions to Mr. Butts and asked that a Verizon representative be present at the October 16 meeting to answer questions for the public.

**CVS Signage:** Mr. Michael Meister of County Builders requested that he be able to relocate certain trees on the CVS property to ensure their proper placement and health. The Board suggested he meet with Township Planner Judith Stern Goldstein to discuss placement. Additionally, he asked to switch lighting of wall-mounted signs from halogen to gooseneck. The Board agreed to the switch.

**Bucks County Art League:** Ms. Judy Foster and Ms. Liz Battaglia had requested that the Bucks County Art League be permitted to use the Village Library Community Room to conduct Saturday art classes. The League was applying for non-profit status, was insured and would post security deposit. The Board agreed to a probationary 6-month period to allow classes to be held on Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. from November 11, 2006 through May 26, 2007 for \$50.00 per week and \$50.00 security deposit. A status meeting would be held at three months.

**Salt Bids 2007:** Ms. Bradley reviewed the results of the Bucks County Consortium Salt Bid, with Cargill Salt the evident low bidder at \$44.03 per ton delivered. The Consortium had received a letter from International Salt (ISCO) offering a lower rate based on the rate ISCO offered to the Commonwealth, although further research would be required to determine if the offer would be valid under State Contract.

**Jericho Valley III Pond:** Mr. Clemons stated that he had received correspondence from the attorney for Mr. and Mrs. Taskin, owners of a fire pond in Jericho Valley III. He responded to the letter, indicating the Township's wish to see the pond repaired and reestablished as a fire pond, and the Township's desire to coordinate efforts to that end.

**Chippewa Renovation Project Update:** Ms. Bradley updated the Board on progress in the Chippewa Farm Renovation Project.

**Gorski Trash Fee:** The Board agreed to return the \$100.00 trash hauler's fee to Gorski, as the fee was no longer valid.

**Budget 2007:** The Board briefly reviewed the proposed 2007 budget.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Lloyd made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne, to adjourn the meeting at 7:55 p.m. All were in favor.
