



ORDINANCE NO. 148

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WRIGHTSTOWN  
PROHIBITING THE PLACEMENT OF SNOW AND ICE INTO  
THE CARTWAY OF PUBLIC STREETS IN THE TOWNSHIP**

**BACKGROUND**

A. Residents of the Township and/or persons acting on their behalf have placed snow and/or ice on the cartways of public roads in the Township in the course of removing snow and/or ice from their driveways and walkways after Township employees have plowed the roadways.

B. The placement of snow and/or ice on the roadways which have been plowed presents a safety hazard to motorists travelling on the roadways and it is in the interest of public safety to prohibit such conduct.

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** as follows:

1. After the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to place snow or ice from property occupied by such person onto the cartway or travel portion of any public road or street in the Township or to cause or permit another to commit such acts by any means whatsoever including the operation of a snow plow, snow blower or other device.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct the cartway or travel portion of any public road or public street in the Township by any means, including the parking or abandoning of any motor vehicle, trailer, machinery or other contrivance on the travel portion

or cartway of any public street or road. The Police Department servicing Wrightstown Township shall the authority to remove any such obstructions.

3. Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance or permits or directs another to violate the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense. The Township Roadmaster or other employee having within the scope of their duties to snow plow the public roads of the Township shall have the authority to bring an action to enforce this Ordinance.

4. This Ordinance shall be incorporated into and become a part of the Codified Ordinances of Wrightstown Township being designated Section 305 of the Codified Ordinances.

5. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of adoption.
