

**Wrightstown Township Historical Commission**  
**Minutes**  
**6 February 2025**

**Call to Order:** Chair Betty Davis called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m.

**Present:**

Members: Betty Davis, chair; Jane DelBianco, Mary Lee Johnson, Beverly Wilson, Karl Niederer (quorum)

Guests: Jane Magne, Township Supervisor

**Agenda:** Additions and changes—None.

**Review of January Meeting Discussion Notes:** Karl Niederer presented Jane DelBianco's discussion notes for the 2 January 2025 meeting, and he thanked her for taking them in his absence. The Chair asked for any corrections or additions; there was none. Karl stated that he would prepare formal minutes for the meeting using the notes and distribute them during February. The Chair asked Karl to place paper copies of all approved meeting minutes in the Commission's binder of minutes in our rooms.

**Treasurer's Report:**

1. Treasurer Jane DelBianco announced that the current balance in the WTHC's 2025 \$1,000 budget is \$750, reflecting payment of \$250 to Joanna Krasnansky for her watercolor of the Wrightstown Quaker Meetinghouse. She added that the WTHC's savings account balance is \$9,263.32. **The Commission VOTED to accept the report.** See ATTACHMENT A.
2. **The Commission VOTED to approve payment of two bills:** (a) Joanna Krasnansky, \$35 for framing a print, and (b) Doylestown Glass Co., \$144.29 for producing a storm window insert sample for the Octagonal School ordered by Mary Lee Johnson.

**Old Business:**

1. **Protecting Octagonal Schoolhouse Windows**—Mary Lee Johnson installed the first sample storm window on the school. The members agreed that it works well and is aesthetically consistent with the building's architecture. Mary Lee will present a request to Township Manager Stacy Crandell for a purchase order to have the other six (6) windows produced by Doylestown Glass Co. to the same specifications at a cost of \$865.74. The first sample window cost \$144.29; the remaining 6 will cost \$865.74.
2. **Placing Prints in Township Building**—Mary Lee Johnson and Karl Niederer hung several framed prints in the public room. Karl agreed to prepare captions for them.
3. **Mega Way Development History**—Beverly Wilson and Jane Magne will begin interviewing community residents in March, starting with Sandy Arnold.
4. **Quaker History Exhibit**—Karl Niederer reported that he had arranged for original deeds and related historical records of Wrightstown Monthly Meeting (1722-1974) to be scanned at the Athenaeum of Philadelphia on 30 January, accompanied by WMM Clerk

Jeff Cogshall. The documents will form a key part of the Commission's planned exhibits. He and Betty Davis would meet with WMM representatives Nancy Culleton and Lois Wilson tomorrow, 7 February, to confirm materials to be displayed.

5. **Photo Album of Octagonal School Roof Replacement**—Karl presented album with the requested cover and spine labels, and a draft introduction. More information about the contracting for the roof replacement is needed from Jane Magne to complete the draft. Mary Lee Johnson stated she has photos of the 1994 roofing project which she will copy to add to album, as well as details about that project to add to the introduction.
6. **Election Statistics**—Mary Lee presented copies of Wrightstown Township's election results and participation statistics in presidential election years 2008-24, obtained from the Bucks County Board of Elections web site. See ATTACHMENT B.
7. **Organizing and Scanning Commission Files**—Jane DelBianco suggested an approach to scanning the contents of the WTHC files using a cell phone scanner. She mentioned that she may have a person willing to perform the work of scanning.


#### **New Business:**

1. **Penns Park Public School/Village Library**—The Chair displayed several historic photos of the school from the WTHC files. She added that the March issue of *Upper Makefield* magazine will include an article on the Village Library of Wrightstown, formerly the Penns Park Public School, which could be posted in the Township's web site.
2. **WTHC Reports to Township Supervisors**—Jane Magne suggested that the WTHC designate one of its members to report on the Commission's activities at future public meetings of the Township Supervisors on the first or third Mondays of each month. Karl Niederer indicated that he could attend the meeting on 18 March.
3. **Protecting Octagonal School Crawl Space**—Mary Lee Johnson recommended replacing the two existing crawl space vents at the base of the school building, which are made of wood and have been eaten through by shelter-seeking groundhogs. She offered to research alternative metal frame and screen replacements and costs.
4. **Donation to WTHC library**—The Chair announced that the John Behrle had presented a copy of *Colonial Inns and Taverns of Bucks County* by Marie Murphy Dues (History Press, 2007) for the Commission's library after their tour of the Octagonal School in October 2024.
